Given the incomplete state of the manuscript draft of the Te Deum and the fact that in many places it represents an earlier phase of composition, the principal source for the present edition is the one published by Chappell in 1845. Certain dynamic marks and indications for the use of the pedals or manuals have, however, been taken from the edition published by Wesley's pupil George Garrett in 1896 (and duly noted in the textual commentary). In the interests of clarity all editorial additions or alterations have also been noted in the textural clarity rather than in the score. Where Wesley's bass line goes below the compass of a 'C' compass organ his original is shown in a separate *ossia* staff (e.g. Te Deum, bars 9-10) and an editorially modified version in the organ part.
