Transcriptions and editions of the Alternative Canticles at Evensong

Blow in E minor, Blow in A major and Purcell in B flat are available in printed and online editions. The remaining settings considered in the paper are transcribed here. The transcriptions contain a modest amount of intervention to create consistency in presentation: modern clefs and voice names have been adopted throughout, along with the BCP text. The original note values, barlines, key and time signatures have been used unless otherwise indicated. Any figured bass given in the sources has been omitted unless it indicates harmony not already present in the voice parts. The principal source employed is indicated in the list below, along with any further sources that have been consulted. Places where significant problems in the principal source have been dealt with are marked in the score with an asterisk.
