
2nd Sunday of Lent (A)

- Our soul is waiting <u>for</u> the Lord.
 He is our help <u>and</u> our shield.
 May your merciful love <u>be</u> upon us, as we hope in <u>you</u>, O Lord. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
