
2nd Sunday of Easter (A)

- 1. Let the house of Israel say: 'His mercy en<u>dures</u> forever.'
 Let the house of Aaron say: 'His mercy en<u>dures</u> forever.'
 Let those who fear the <u>Lord</u> say:
 'his mercy en<u>dures</u> forever.' *R*
- 2. They pushed me, pushed me hard to knock me down, but the Lord was my helper.The Lord is my strength and my song; he was my saviour. R
- 3. The stone which the builders rejected has become the <u>cor</u>nerstone. By the Lord has this been done, a marvel <u>in</u> our eyes. This is day the <u>Lord</u> has made; let us rejoice in it <u>and</u> be glad. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
