
15th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- You visit the earth, give it water; you fill it with riches.
 God's ever-flowing river brims over to prepare the grain. *R*
- 2. And thus <u>you</u> prepare it; you <u>drench</u> its furrows; you level it, soften <u>it</u> with showers; you <u>bless</u> its growth. *R*
- 3. You crown the year <u>with</u> your bounty. Abundance flows <u>in</u> your pathways; in pastures of the des<u>ert</u> it flows. *R*
- 4. The hills are gird<u>ed</u> with joy, the meadows <u>clothed</u> with flocks. The valleys are <u>decked</u> with wheat. They shout for joy; <u>yes</u>, they sing! *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
