

The Transfiguration of the Lord (A,B,C)

 justice and right are the foundation <u>of</u> his throne. *R*
- 2. The mountains <u>melt</u> like wax before the face <u>of</u> the Lord, The skies pro<u>claim</u> his justice; all peoples <u>see</u> his glory. *R*
- 3. For you indeed <u>are</u> the Lord, most high above <u>all</u> the earth, exalted far above all gods, exalted far above all spirits. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
