
20th Sunday of Ordinary Time (A)

- 3. Let the peoples praise <u>you</u>, O God, let all the <u>peoples</u> praise you.May God still give <u>us</u> his blessing that all the ends of the earth <u>may</u> revere him. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
