
Exaltation of the Holy Cross (A,B,C)

- 1. Give ear, my people, to my teaching; incline your ear to the words of my mouth. I will open my mouth in a parable and utter hidden lessons of the past. **R**
- 2. When he slew them, <u>then</u> they sought him, repented and earnestly sought God. They would remember that God <u>was</u> their rock, God the Most High <u>their</u> redeemer. *R*
- 3. Yet they deceived him <u>with</u> their mouths; they lied to him <u>with</u> their tongues. For their hearts were not stead<u>fast</u> toward him; they were not faithful <u>to</u> his covenant. *R*
- 4. Yet he who is full of compassion forgave them their sin and spared them. So often he held back his anger, and did not stir up all his rage. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and then sung by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
