

- 2. Truly, I have <u>set</u> my soul in tranquillity and silence.Like a weaned child <u>on</u> its mother, as a weaned child is my <u>soul</u> within me. *R*
- 3. O Israel, hope <u>in</u> the Lord, both now <u>and</u> forever. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
