
Baptism (B)

- 1. Truly, God is my salvation, I trust, I <u>shall</u> not fear. For the Lord is my strength, my song, he be<u>came</u> my Saviour. With joy you <u>will</u> draw water from the wells <u>of</u> salvation.
- 2. Give thanks to the Lord, give praise to his name!

 Make his mighty deeds known to the peoples!

 Declare the greatness of his name.
- 3. Sing a psalm to the Lord for he has done <u>glor</u>ious deeds; make them known to <u>all</u> the earth! People of Zion, sing and <u>shout</u> for joy, for great in your midst is the Holy <u>One</u> of Israel.

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
