
## Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

- 3. The Lord is good and upright.

  He shows the path to those who stray, he guides the humble in the right path; he teaches his way to the poor. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
