
## Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 84, vv 1-2, 6-9; refrain v 9

- 1. Come, ring out our joy <u>to</u> the Lord; hail the <u>rock</u> who saves us.

  Let us come before him <u>giving</u> thanks, with songs let us <u>hail</u> the Lord. *R*
- 2. Come in: let us kneel <u>and</u> bend low; let us kneel before <u>God</u> who made us; for he is our God and we the people who belong <u>to</u> his pasture, the flock that is led by his hand. *R*
- 3. O that today you would listen to his voice!

  'Harden not your hearts as at Meribah, as on that day at Massah in the desert when your fathers put me to the test; when they tried me, though they saw my work'. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
