
## First Sunday of Advent (B)

Psalm 79, vv 2-3, 15-16, 18-19; refrain v 4

- 1. O shepherd of Is<u>ra</u>el, hear us, shine forth from your cher<u>u</u>bim throne. O Lord, rouse <u>up</u> your might, O Lord, come to our help. *R*
- 2. God of hosts, turn again, <u>we</u> implore, look down from hea<u>ven</u> and see. Visit this vine <u>and</u> protect it, the vine your right <u>hand</u> has planted. *R*
- 3. May your hand be on the man <u>you</u> have chosen, the man you have gi<u>ven</u> your strength. And we shall never forsake <u>you</u> again: give us life that we may call up<u>on</u> your name. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
