
## Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday)

Psalm 22, vv 8-9, 17-20, 23-4; refrain v 2

- 1. All who see <u>me</u> deride me. They curl their lips, they <u>toss</u> their heads. 'He trusted in the Lord, <u>let</u> him save him; let him release him if this is his friend'. *R*
- 2. Many dogs <u>have</u> surrounded me, a band of the wick<u>ed</u> beset me. They tear holes in my hands <u>and</u> my feet I can count ev'ry one <u>of</u> my bones. *R*
- 3. They divide my clothing among them. They cast lots for my robe.
  O Lord, do not leave me alone, my strength, make haste to help me! *R*
- 4. I will tell of your name to my brethren and praise you where they <u>are</u> assembled. 'You who fear the Lord <u>give</u> him praise; all sons of Jacob, <u>give</u> him glory. Revere him, <u>Is</u>rael's sons.' *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
