
Second Sunday after Easter (B)

Let those who <u>fear</u> the Lord say: 'his love <u>has</u> no end'. *R*

2. The stone which the builders rejected has become the <u>cornerstone</u>. This is the work of the Lord, a marvel <u>in</u> our eyes. This day was made <u>by</u> the Lord; We rejoice <u>and</u> are glad. R

3. O Lord, grant us salvation; O Lord, grant success. Blessed in the name of the Lord is <u>he</u> who comes. We bless you from the house <u>of</u> the Lord; The Lord God <u>is</u> our light. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
