
Fifth Sunday of Easter (B)

Psalm 21, vv 26-28, 30-32; refrain v 26

- 1. My vows I will pay before <u>those</u> who fear him. The poor shall eat and shall <u>have</u> their fill. They shall praise the Lord, <u>those</u> who seek him. May their hearts live for ever and ever. *R*
- 2. All the earth shall remember and return <u>to</u> the Lord all families of the nations wor<u>ship</u> before him. They shall worship him, all the mighty <u>of</u> the earth; before him shall bow all who go down to the dust. *R*
- 3. And my soul shall live for him, my <u>children</u> serve him. They shall tell of the Lord to generations <u>yet</u> to come, declare his faithfulness to peoples <u>yet</u> unborn: 'These things the Lord has done.' *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
