
Sixth Sunday of Easter (B)

Psalm 97, vv 1-4; refrain v 2

- 1. Sing a new <u>song</u> to the Lord for he <u>has</u> worked wonders. His right hand and his <u>ho</u>ly arm have <u>brought</u> salvation. *R*
- 2. The Lord has made <u>known</u> his salvation; he has shown his justice <u>to</u> the nations. He has remembered his <u>truth</u> and love for the house of Israel. *R*
- 3. All the ends of the <u>earth</u> have seen the salvation <u>of</u> our God. Shout to the Lord <u>all</u> the earth, ring <u>out</u> your joy. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
