
The Ascension of the Lord (B)

Psalm 46, vv 2-3, 6-9; refrain v 6

- 1. All peoples, <u>clap</u> your hands, cry to God with <u>shouts</u> of joy! For the Lord, the most high, <u>we</u> must fear, great King over <u>all</u> the earth. *R*
- 2. God goes up with <u>shouts</u> of joy; the Lord goes up with <u>trumpet blast</u>. Sing praise for <u>God</u>, sing praise, sing praise to our <u>King</u>, sing praise. *R*
- 3. God is the King of <u>all</u> the earth. Sing praise with <u>all</u> your skill. God is King o<u>ver</u> the nations; God reigns on his <u>ho</u>ly throne. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
