
Seventh Sunday of Easter (B)

2. For as the heav'ns are high above the earth so strong is his love for those who fear Him. As far as the east is from the west so far does he remove our sins. **R**

3. The Lord has set his <u>sway</u> in heav'n and his kingdom is ruling <u>over all</u>. Give thanks to the Lord, <u>all</u> his angels, mighty in power, fulfilling His word. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
