
The Most Holy Trinity (B)

1. The word of the <u>Lord</u> is faithful and all his works <u>to</u> be trusted. The Lord loves jus<u>tice</u> and right and fills the earth <u>with</u> his love. R

2. By his word the <u>heav'ns</u> were made, by the breath of his mouth <u>all</u> the stars.
He spoke; and they <u>came</u> to be.
He commanded; they sprang <u>in</u>to being. *R*

3. The Lord looks on those <u>who</u> revere him on those who hope <u>in</u> his love, to rescue their <u>souls</u> from death, to keep them a<u>live</u> in famine. R

4. Our soul is waiting <u>for</u> the Lord. The Lord is our help <u>and</u> our shield. May Your love be upon <u>us</u>, O Lord, as we place all our <u>hope</u> in You. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
