Psalm 122 ; refrain v 2

R Our eyes are on the Lord till he show us his mer - cy.

1. To you I have lifted up my eyes,
you who dwell in the heav'ns:
my eyes, like the eyes of slaves
on the hand of their lords. *R*

2. Like the eyes of a servant
on the hand of her mistress,
so our eyes are on the Lord our God
till he show us his mercy. *R*

3. Have mercy on us, Lord, have mercy.
We are filled with contempt.
Indeed, all too full is our soul with the scorn of the rich,
with the proud man's disdain. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
