
15th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 84, vv 9-14; refrain v 8

- 1. I will hear what the Lord God <u>has</u> to say, a voice that speaks of peace, peace <u>for</u> his people. His help is near for <u>those</u> who fear him and his glory will dwell in our land. *R*
- 2. Mercy and faithful<u>ness</u> have met; justice and peace <u>have</u> embraced. Faithfulness shall spring <u>from</u> the earth and justice look <u>down</u> from heav'n. *R*
- 3. The Lord will <u>make</u> us prosper and our earth shall <u>yield</u> its fruit. Justice shall <u>march</u> before him and peace shall follow his steps. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
