
## Third Sunday of Advent (B)

Luke 1, vv 46-50, 53-54; refrain Isaiah 61, v 10

- 1. My soul <u>glorifies</u> the Lord, my spirit rejoices in <u>God</u>, my saviour. He looks on his servant <u>in</u> her nothingness, henceforth all ages will <u>call</u> me bless'd. *R*
- 2. The Almighty works <u>mar</u>vels for me. Ho<u>ly</u>, his name! His mercy is from <u>age</u> to age, on <u>those</u> who fear him. *R*
- 3. He fills the starving with good things, sends the rich away empty. He protects Israel, his servant, rememb'ring his mercy. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
