
## 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 144, vv 10-11, 15-18; refrain v 16

1. All your creatures shall thank <u>you</u>, O Lord, and your friends shall re<u>peat</u> their blessing. They shall speak of the glory <u>of</u> your reign and declare your might, O God. R

2. The eyes of all creatures <u>look</u> to you and you give them their food <u>in</u> due time. You open <u>wide</u> your hand, grant the desires of <u>all</u> who live. R

3. The Lord is just in <u>all</u> his ways and loving in <u>all</u> his deeds.
He is close to <u>all</u> who call him, who call on him <u>from</u> their hearts. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
