
## 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 77, vv 3-4, 23-25, 54; refrain v 24

- 1. The things we have heard and <u>un</u>derstood, the things our fa<u>thers</u> have told us, we will tell to the next <u>generation</u>: the glories of the Lord <u>and</u> his might. *R*
- 2. He commanded the <u>clouds</u> above and opened the <u>gates</u> of heav'n. He rained down manna <u>for</u> their food, and gave them bread from heav'n. *R*
- 3. Mere men ate the <u>bread</u> of angels. He sent them abun<u>dance</u> of food. He brought them to his <u>ho</u>ly land, to the mountain which his right <u>hand</u> had won. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
