
## 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 33, vv 2-9; refrain v 9

 I will bless the Lord <u>at</u> all times, his praise always <u>on</u> my lips; in the Lord my soul shall <u>make</u> its boast. The humble shall hear <u>and</u> be glad. *R*

2. Glorify the Lord with me.
Together let us praise his name.
I sought the Lord and he answered me; from all my terrors he set me free. *R*

3. Look towards him <u>and</u> be radiant; let your faces not <u>be</u> abashed. This poor man called; the <u>Lord</u> heard him and rescued him from all <u>his</u> distress. **R** 

4. The angel of the Lord <u>is</u> encamped around those who revere <u>him</u>, to rescue them. Taste and see that the <u>Lord</u> is good. He is happy who seeks refuge in him. **R** 

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
