
22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 14, vv 2-5; refrain v 1

- 1. Lord, who shall dwell on your <u>ho</u>ly mountain? He who walks <u>with</u>out fault; he who <u>acts</u> with justice and speaks the truth from his heart. *R*
- 2. He who does no wrong to his brother, who casts no slur on his neighbour, who holds the godless in disdain, but honours those who fear the Lord. **R**
- 3. He who keeps his pledge, <u>come</u> what may; who takes no interest <u>on</u> a loan and accepts no bribes <u>against</u> the innocent. Such a man will stand firm for ever. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
