
## 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 145, vv 7-10; refrain v 1

1. It is the Lord who keeps <u>faith</u> for ever, who is just to those who <u>are</u> oppressed. It is he who gives bread <u>to</u> the hungry, the Lord, who sets prisoners free. R

2. It is the Lord who gives sight <u>to</u> the blind who raises up those who <u>are</u> bowed down, the Lord who <u>loves</u> the just, the Lord, who protects the stranger. R

3. The Lord upholds the wi<u>dow</u> and orphan, but thwarts the path <u>of</u> the wicked. The Lord will <u>reign</u> for ever, Zion's God, from <u>age</u> to age. **R** 

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
