
## 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 114, vv 1-6, 8-9; refrain v 9

1. I love the Lord, for <u>he</u> has heard the cry of <u>my</u> appeal; for he turned his <u>ear</u> to me in the day when I called him. *R* 

2. They surround me, the snares of death, with the anguish <u>of</u> the tomb; they caught me, sorrow <u>and</u> distress.

I called <u>on</u> the Lord's name.

O Lord my God, de <u>liver me!</u> R

3. How gracious is the <u>Lord</u> and just; our God <u>has</u> compassion.
The Lord protects the <u>simple</u> hearts; I was helpless, <u>so</u> he saved me. *R* 

4. He has kept my <u>soul</u> from death, my eyes from tears and my <u>feet</u> from stumbling. I will walk in the presence <u>of</u> the Lord in the land of the living. **R** 

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
