
## 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 53, vv 3-6, 8; refrain v 6

- 1. O God, save me <u>by</u> your name; by your power, up<u>hold</u> my cause. O God, <u>hear</u> my prayer; listen to the words <u>of</u> my mouth. *R*
- 2. For proud men have <u>ris'n</u> against me, ruthless men <u>seek</u> my life. They have no regard for God. *R*
- 3. But I have God <u>for</u> my help. The Lord up<u>holds</u> my life. I will sacrifice to you with <u>will</u>ing heart and praise your name, for <u>it</u> is good. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
