
28th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

1. Make us know the shortness <u>of</u> our life that we may gain wis<u>dom</u> of heart. Lord, relent! Is your anger for ever? Show pity <u>to</u> your servants. **R**

2. In the morning, fill us <u>with</u> your love; we shall rejoice and exult <u>all</u> our days. Give us joy to balance <u>our</u> affliction for the years when we <u>knew</u> misfortune. R

3. Show forth your work <u>to</u> your servants; let your glory shine <u>on</u> their children. Let the favour of the Lord <u>be</u> upon us; give success to the work <u>of</u> our hands. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
