
29th Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

- 1. The word of the <u>Lord</u> is faithful and all his works <u>to</u> be trusted. The Lord loves jus<u>tice</u> and right and fills the earth <u>with</u> his love. *R*
- 2. The Lord looks on those who revere him, on those who hope in his love, to rescue their souls from death, to keep them alive in famine. *R*
- 3. Our soul is waiting <u>for</u> the Lord. The Lord is our help <u>and</u> our shield. May your love be upon <u>us</u>, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
