
32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)

Psalm 145, vv 7-10; refrain v 2

- 1. It is the Lord who keeps <u>faith</u> for ever, who is just to those who <u>are</u> oppressed. It is he who gives bread <u>to</u> the hungry, the Lord, who sets prisoners free. *R*
- 2. It is the Lord who gives sight <u>to</u> the blind, who raises up those who <u>are</u> bowed down, the Lord, who <u>loves</u> the just, the Lord, who protects the stranger. *R*
- 3. The Lord upholds the widow and orphan, but thwarts the path of the wicked. The Lord will reign for ever, Zion's God, from age to age. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all; it is then repeated by all after each verse.
