R Pre - serve me, O God, I take re - fuge in you.



1. O Lord, it is you who are my portion and cup;
it is you yourself who are my prize.
I keep the Lord ever in my sight:
since he is at my right hand, I shall stand firm. *R*

2. And so my heart rejoices, my soul is glad;
even my body shall rest in safety.
For you will not leave me among the dead,
nor let your beloved know decay. *R*

3. You will show me the path of life,
the fullness of joy in your presence,
at your right hand happiness for ever,
at your right hand happiness for ever. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor, and then sung by all;
it is then repeated by all after each verse.
