
2nd Sunday of Easter (C)

- Let the house of Israel say, 'His mercy endures for ever.'
 Let the house of Aaron say, 'His mercy endures for ever.'
 Let those who fear the <u>Lord</u> say, 'His mercy endures for ever.' *R*
- 2. The stone that the builders rejected has become the <u>cor</u>nerstone. By the Lord this has been done, a marvel <u>in</u> our eyes. This is the day the <u>Lord</u> has made; let us rejoice in it <u>and</u> be glad. **R**
- 3. We beseech you, O Lord, grant salvation; We beseech you, O Lord, grant success. Blest is he who comes in the name of the Lord. We bless you from the house of the Lord; the Lord is God, and has given us light. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
