
## 4th Sunday of Easter (C)

**Responsorial Psalm**: Psalm 99(100): 1-3, 5. R. v. 3 Robert Gower (b.1952)



- Cry out with joy to the Lord, <u>all</u> the earth. Serve the <u>Lord</u> with gladness. Come before him, singing for joy. *R*
- 2. Know that he, the Lord, is God.
  He made us, we belong to him, we are his people, the sheep of his flock. *R*
- 3. Indeed, how good <u>is</u> the Lord, eternal his mer<u>ci</u>ful love.He is faithful from <u>age</u> to age. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
