

- 2. All your works shall thank <u>you</u>, O Lord and all your faith<u>ful</u> ones bless you. They shall speak of the glory <u>of</u> your reign and declare your mighty deeds, and the glorious splendour <u>of</u> your reign. *R*
- 3. Your kingdom is an ever<u>lasting kingdom</u>, Your rule endures for all <u>gen</u>erations. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
