
6th Sunday of Easter (C)

- 1. May God be gracious and bless us and let his face shed its <u>light</u> upon us. So will your ways be known <u>up</u>on earth and all nations learn <u>your</u> salvation. *R*
- 2. Let the nations be glad and shout for joy; with uprightness you <u>rule</u> the peoples, you guide the nations on earth. *R*
- 3. Let the peoples praise <u>you</u>, O God; let all the peoples <u>praise</u> you.

 May God still give <u>us</u> his blessing that all the ends of the earth <u>may</u> revere him. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
