
20th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

- 1. I waited, I waited <u>for</u> the Lord and he stooped <u>down</u> to me; he <u>heard</u> my cry. *R*
- 2. He drew me from the <u>dead</u>ly pit, from the <u>mi</u>ry clay.He set my feet u<u>pon</u> a rock, made my <u>foot</u>steps firm. *R*
- 3. He put a new song into my mouth, praise of our God.Many shall see and fear and shall trust in the Lord. R
- 4. Wretched and poor though I am, the Lord is mindful of me.You are my rescuer, my help;O my God, do not delay. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
