
4th Sunday of Advent (C)

 Rouse up your might and <u>come</u> to save us. *R*
- God of hosts, turn again, we implore; look down from heaven and see.
 Visit this vine and protect it, the stock your right hand has planted. R
- 3. May your hand be on the man <u>at</u> your right hand, the son of man you have confirmed <u>as</u> your own. And we shall never forsake <u>you</u> again; give us life that we may call up<u>on</u> your name. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
