
26th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 145(146):6-10. R cf. v. 2 Robert Gower (b.1952)



- It is the Lord who preserves fidelity for ever, who does justice to those who <u>are</u> oppressed. It is he who gives bread <u>to</u> the hungry, the Lord who sets <u>pri</u>soners free. *R*
- 2. The Lord who opens the eyes of the blind, the Lord who raises up those who are bowed down. It is the Lord who loves the just, the Lord, who protects the stranger. *R*
- He upholds the widow and orphan but thwarts the path of the wicked. The Lord will reign for ever, your God, O Zion, from age to age. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
