
## 27th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 95: 1-4. R v. 8

**R** O that to - day you would lis-ten to his voice! Har - den not your hearts.





- Come, let us ring out our joy to the Lord; hail the <u>rock</u> who saves us.
   Let us come into his presence, <u>giving</u> thanks; let us hail him with a <u>song</u> of praise. *R*
- 2. O come; let us bow <u>and</u> bend low.

  Let us kneel before the <u>Lord</u> who made us,
  for he is our God, and we the people, the people <u>of</u> his pasture,
  the flock <u>of</u> his hand. *R*
- 3. O that today you would listen <u>to</u> his voice!

  "Harden not your hearts as <u>at</u> Meribah,
  as on that day at Massah in the desert when your forebears put me <u>to</u> the test;
  when they tried me, though they <u>saw</u> my work." *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
