
## 28th Sunday of Ordinary time (C)

- O sing a new song to the Lord for he <u>has</u> worked wonders.
   His right hand and his <u>holy</u> arm have <u>brought</u> salvation. *R*
- The Lord has made known <u>his</u> salvation, has shown his deliverance <u>to</u> the nations. He has remembered his mer<u>ciful</u> love and his truth for the <u>house</u> of Israel. *R*
- 3 All the ends of the <u>earth</u> have seen the salvation <u>of</u> our God. Shout to the Lord, <u>all</u> the earth; sing <u>out</u> your praise. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
