

- I will bless the Lord <u>at</u> all times, praise of him is always <u>in</u> my mouth.
 In the Lord my soul shall <u>make</u> its boast; the humble shall hear <u>and</u> be glad. *R*
- 2. The Lord turns his face against the wicked to cut off their remembrance from the earth. When the just one cries, the Lord hears, and rescues him in all his distress. *R*
- The Lord is close to the <u>broken hearted</u>; those whose spirit is crushed <u>he</u> will save.
 The Lord ransoms the souls <u>of</u> his servants.
 All who trust in him shall not be condemned. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
