

- The Lord is kind and full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy.
 How good is the Lord to all, compassionate to all his creatures. R
- 3. All your works shall thank <u>you</u>, O Lord and all your faith<u>ful</u> ones bless you. They shall speak of the glory <u>of</u> your reign and declare your <u>mighty</u> deeds. *R*
- 4. The Lord is faithful in <u>all</u> his words, and holy in <u>all</u> his deeds.
 The Lord supports <u>all</u> who fall and raises up all who <u>are</u> bowed down. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
